QUICK GUIDE TO FACT CHECKING

Guidelines

1 Source Credibility

Check the reputation and history of the source.

Verify if the source has a clear editorial policy and follows journalistic standards.

2 Authorship Verification

Confirm the author's credentials and expertise.

Cross-reference the author's work to ensure consistency and reliability.

3 Publication Date

Verify the publication date to ensure the information is current.

Consider the timeliness of the information in relation to the topic.

4 Corroboration

Cross-check the information with multiple reputable sources.

Be cautious if the information is not independently verified by other credible outlets.

5 Contextual Understanding

Evaluate if the information is presented in a broader context.

Verify if key details or nuances are omitted to manipulate the narrative.

6 Fact vs. Opinion

Distinguish between factual information and opinion.

Be cautious of articles that blur the line between news and commentary.

7 Quotation Authenticity

Verify the authenticity of quotes by checking primary sources.

Be cautious of misrepresented or out-of-context quotations.

8 Visual Content Verification

Confirm the authenticity of images or videos.

Utilize reverse image searches to identify potential manipulations.

9 Cross-Check Statistics

Verify statistical information with official databases or reliable research institutions.

Be cautious of statistics presented without proper context or sources.

10 Bias Assessment

Identify potential bias in the language and tone used.

Consider the overall perspective of the article and assess its objectivity.

11 Logical Consistency

Evaluate the logical flow and consistency of the information.

Be cautious of articles with logical fallacies or inconsistencies.

12 Check the Domain

Verify the legitimacy of the website domain.

Be cautious of websites with misleading URLs or imitating reputable sources.

13 Review Comments and Reactions

Assess the comments section for additional insights or corrections.

Consider the quality of engagement and whether it reflects a thoughtful discussion

14 Retractions or Corrections

Investigate if the source has a history of retractions or corrections.

Consider the transparency and accountability of the news outlet.

15 Consult Fact-Checking Organizations

Refer to fact-checking organizations for additional verification.

Cross-check the information with reputable fact-checking websites.

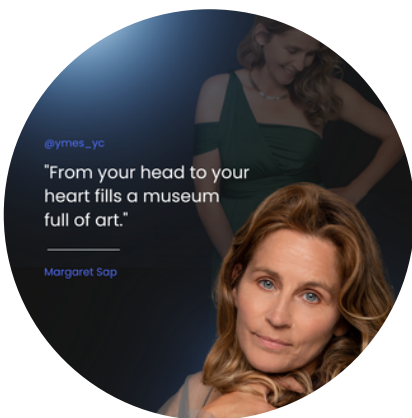
